



Caring Breaths Financial Assistance Program Lung Cancer and Radon Mitigation

Luana's Legacy Fund

Primary Caregivers of and/or people living with or have had lung cancer may be eligible for the following reimbursements:

Medical expenses

- Medical Equipment and medical equipment rental costs. Note: Funding should first be requested from SAIL or SaskAbilities. Medication of any kind will not be reimbursed
- Pulmonary rehabilitation fees and exercise equipment

Travel and accommodations

- Travel and accommodations for medical care/appointments

Fees and other eligible expenses

- Cost of a private company to maintain care for Saskatchewan primary home residence if individuals are unable to do so due to their lung cancer diagnosis
- Hospital parking fees
- Costs associated with end-of-life care

Radon Mitigation Reimbursements

- Radon mitigation must be completed by a [Canadian-National Radon Proficiency Program \(C-NRPP\)](#) certified radon professional
- Only an applicant's single detached primary residents will be considered
- A maximum of up to \$500.00 for radon mitigation may be reimbursed to a household. Those who had or have an individual living in the home with a lung cancer diagnosis may be considered for up to \$1000.00 reimbursement
- Financial need must be demonstrated. Reimbursement decisions will be based on financial need, number of occupants in the home

Who can provide a referral? Physicians and Nurse Practitioners, Nurses, Social Workers, Physiotherapists, Pulmonary Rehab Exercise Therapists, Certified Respiratory Educators, Respiratory Therapists, and Pharmacists.

Who Cannot Provide a Referral? Medical equipment suppliers, and immediate family members of the applicant.
