


HOW TO USE A LUPINHALER

Before use, peel back foil until 1 capsule is exposed. Remove one capsule at a time.

- 1. Open the lid by pressing green piercing button and pulling the lid upwards. Open the mouthpiece by pulling upwards to expose the center chamber.
- 2. Remove a capsule from the blister package and place in the chamber. Close the mouthpiece until you hear a click. Leave the lid open.
- 3. Hold the inhaler upright (mouthpiece upwards) and press the green piercing button once, then release.
- 4. Breathe out, away from the mouthpiece.
- 5. Seal your lips around the mouthpiece. Tilt your chin up slightly and breath in slowly and deeply until your lungs are full. A strong enough inhalation will cause the capsule to vibrate.
- 6. Remove the inhaler from your mouth while still holding your breath for a count of 5-10 seconds.
- 7. Breathe out, away from the mouthpiece.
- 8. Repeat steps 4-7 for a second time.
- 9. Open the mouthpiece, and dispose of the capsule. Close the mouthpiece and lid.
- 10. Wash your hands.



CARE OF A LUPINHALER

The LupinHaler needs to be cleaned once a month, or as needed.

- 1. Open the dust cap and mouthpiece. Firmly grip the green piercing button and lift up.
- 2. Rinse the inhaler with warm water to remove any powder.
- 3. Leave the inhaler with the dust cap, mouthpiece, and base open, and place on paper towel to air dry.
- 4. Air drying takes 24 hours, so clean the inhaler immediately after use.
- 5. The mouthpiece may be wiped with a damp tissue as needed. *Do not place in the dishwasher*
- 6. Discard the LupinHaler 12 months after first use.
- 7. Always check the inhaler's expiration date.

Important information:

Lupinhaler is the name of the inhaler delivery device. Medication in this device has a brand name and generic name.

Inhalers available in the Lupinhaler:

PRLupin Tiotroprium
Generic name: tiotropium bromide monohydrate
Dose per puff: 18 mcg
Duration: 24 hours
