## Why Invest in Lung Saskatchewan?

Our commitment to improving lung health in Saskatchewan began in 1911 during the tuberculosis epidemic that swept across the province and Canada. Today, we continue to work for the people affected by lung diseases such as asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, pulmonary fibrosis, lung cancer, and sleep apnea.

Because of our efforts, Saskatchewan has seen tremendous strides in lung health education, advocacy, and research. It is through these priorities we are able to offer best-in-class, timely, and relevant opportunities to all of our stakeholders.

Lung Saskatchewan invests in lung health research happening right in Saskatchewan, and we work to advance lung health priorities at the municipal, provincial, and federal level. Our programs and services focus on protecting lung health, preventing lung disease, and ensuring that the resources are available for people who need them.

2024 Achievements:

- Advocated for restrictions on nicotine pouches to protect youth, leading to a nationwide ban of Zonnic products in stores as of August 28, 2024. Now available only behind pharmacy counters as a Nicotine Replacement Therapy.
- Provided financial assistance through the Caring Breaths program to individuals in 34 Saskatchewan communities, supporting those with lung disease and people completing radon mitigation.
- Invested over \$200,000 to Saskatchewan-based lung health research in partnership with the Saskatchewan Health Research Foundation.
- Expanded radon testing options to include continuous radon monitors, while supporting library lending programs in three communities. If you have not tested your home yet visit HomeRadonTest.ca.
- Grew membership in six online support communities for people living with asthma, lung transplant, sleep apnea, COVID-19, pulmonary fibrosis, and smoking cessation.
- Delivered the Saskatchewan Quit Smoking Challenge, growing our online quit-smoking community to over 890 members province-wide.
